**WATER POLLUTION CONTROL PERMIT**

To whom it may concern:

This is to certify that Westrans Petroleum, Inc., P. O. Box 4276, Parkersburg, W.V. 26101

is hereby granted a Water Pollution Control Permit to operate a new disposal well for the subsurface reinjection of salt water wastes accumulated in the process of oil well operation. This well is identified as the C. T. Harper Heirs Well No. 1 in the Harper District of Roane County (ROA - 1926

This permit is subject to the following terms and conditions:

The maximum injection pressure, measured at the well head, shall not exceed 976 pounds per square inch. With the foregoing exception the information submitted on and with Permit Application No. W-89, dated the 13th day of May, 1971 is all hereby made terms and conditions of this permit with like effect as if such permit application information were set forth herein.

The quality of the surface and ground waters are to be maintained at satisfactory levels and operation of the proposed facilities, including any adjacent monitoring wells, are not to cause any of the following conditions to exist in either the surface or ground waters of the State:

- (a) Distinctly visible floating or settleable solids, suspended solids, scum, foam or oily slicks of unreasonable kind or quantity;
- (b) Objectionable bottom deposits or sludge banks;
- (c) Objectionable odors in the vicinity of the waters;
- (d) Objectionable taste and/or odor in municipal water supplies;
- (e) Concentrations of materials poisonous to man, animal or fish life;
- (f) Dissolved oxygen concentration to be less than 3.0 parts per million at the point of maximum oxygen depletion;
- (g) Objectionable color;
- (h) Objectionable bacterial concentrations;
- (i) Requiring an unreasonable degree of treatment for the production of potable water by modern water treatment processes as commonly employed.

The above-described activity is to be extended, modified, added to, made, enlarged, acquired, constructed or installed, and operated, used and maintained strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit; with the plans and specifications submitted with Permit Application No. W-89, dated the 13 day of May, 1971; with the plan of maintenance and method of operation thereof submitted with such application; and with any present or future rules and regulations duly adopted by the State Water Resources Board.

Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this permit, with the plans and specifications submitted with Permit Application No. W-89, dated the 13th day of May, 1971, with the plan of maintenance and method of operation thereof submitted with such application, shall constitute grounds for the revocation or suspension of this permit and for the invocation of all the enforcement procedures set forth in Article 5A, Chapter 20 of the Code of West Virginia.

This permit is issued in accordance with the provisions of Article 5A, Chapter 20 of the Code of West Virginia and is transferable under the terms of Section 7 of said article.
